



SOLO OPEN MEETING

Saturday 22nd May 2021

Notice of Race.

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the National Solo Class Rules, the Sailing instructions (SI's) and this Notice of Race. In the case of conflict, the SI's will prevail.
- 1.2 Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - i. Rule 33 - Marks may be moved by the race committee at any time, with no notification to competitors. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
 - ii. Rule 40 - is changed in that a PFD shall be always worn by anyone afloat, without flag Y being displayed.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2.0 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 The Organising Authority may require competing boats to carry event sponsor advertising on the hull.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Solo class.
- 3.2 Boats shall be sailed by one person.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter either:
 - i. **by completing the online entry form – preferred method**
 - ii by completing the entry form and submitting, together with the required fee, to the race organisers, during the registration period.
- 3.4 An entry is not complete until:
 - i. Entry fees have been paid in full.
 - ii. A crew list, medical and declaration form, available at registration, has been signed by the competitor.
 - iii. A parental (or guardian) consent form and declaration has been submitted for any competitor aged under 18.

4.0 FEES

- 4.1 The required entry fee is £15 per boat.

5.0 COMPETITION FORMAT

- 5.1 The event will consist of three races with one discard if three races are sailed.

6.0 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration will take place on Saturday 22nd May 2021 from 0900 until 1015.
- 6.2 The briefing will take place on Saturday 22nd May 2021 at 1020.
- 6.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be at 1100 hours on Saturday 22nd May 2021.
- 6.4 Subsequent race times will be announced on the day.

7.0 MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Each boat may be asked to produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 Boats may be permitted, at the sole discretion of the race committee, to race without a measurement certificate. If a measurement certificate is not produced, the boat may be excluded from receiving prizes.

8.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the event registration and on the RSC web site at www.rscsailing.org

9.0 VENUE and COURSES

- 9.1 The regatta office will be situated in the gazebo.
- 9.2 Racing will take place on Troy Lake.
- 9.3 Courses will be a combination of marks laid as described in the sailing instructions.

10.0 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Rule 44.3 (scoring penalty) does not apply.

11.0 SCORING

- 11.1 The low points scoring system, as described in Appendix A of the RRS shall apply.
- 11.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 When fewer than three races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.4 When three or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12.0 SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1 Support boats shall not be permitted without the permission of the race committee.

13.0 BERTHING

- 13.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

14.0 PRIZES

- 14.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.

15.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16.0 INSURANCE

- 16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000, 000 (three million pounds) per incident or the equivalent.

17.0 COVID

- 17.1 By taking part in any of the events covered by this notice of race, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that they are responsible for complying with any regulations in force from time to time in respect of COVID-19 and for complying with the Rickmansworth Sailing Club COVID-19 procedures. Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Failure to comply may be misconduct. Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols, or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions. A breach of this rule shall not be grounds for protest by another boat. This amends rule 60.1(a).
